The [Associazione Carlo Giannini](#) and the [EIEF](#) jointly organise a **workshop** for Ph.D. students and postdoctoral researchers with a field of specialisation in **macroeconometrics and time series econometrics**.

The aim of the meeting is to bring together young researchers in applied and theoretical econometrics and introduce them to the Italian econometric profession.

The presentation will be **informal** and the aim is to provide constructive criticism. Ideally, the papers presented should be at a stage of completion typical of a job market paper.

Format of the meeting: A full day meeting, with 5 papers. Each paper will be presented in **40** minutes, leaving the remaining **20** to the discussion and the rejoinder by the author.

The **first edition** was held at the University of **Brescia** in December 2009 and it focused on financial econometrics.

Date, venue and theme for the Second Workshop: **10th December 2010**, from 1100 to 1700 at the [EIEF](#), Via Sallustiana 62, **Rome**.
